Fifth Sunday of Easter

The resurrection of Jesus makes it clear that He truly is the Son of God. The Gospel of this Fifth Sunday of Easter reveals to us the intimate union of the Son and the Father, which allows us to enter into the knowledge of the mystery of God and of His saving work.

Jesus presents Himself to us as “the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” If we want to know the Father who raised Jesus from the dead and who will also raise us, we must listen to His Son. He is the one who reveals Him to us. He is the way that leads us to the true God and giver of life for all humanity—the Father of all, without distinctions of race, social status, or gender.

From the resurrection of Jesus is born the new people of God, in whom Christ is “the living stone rejected by men, but chosen and precious in the sight of God.” A new people born not of human lineage like the people of the old covenant, but of baptism, in which we can all relate directly to God as beloved children, chosen to carry forward the mission of the Risen One. A people called to be a “universal sacrament of fraternity” in a world divided by wars and discrimination.

Quinto Dgo. De Pascua.

La resurrección de Jesús pone de manifiesto que verdaderamente es el Hijo de Dios. El Evangelio de este V Domingo de Pascua nos revela la íntima unión del Hijo y el Padre que nos permite adentrarnos en el conocimiento del misterio de Dios y de su obra salvadora.

Jesús se nos presenta como “El Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Nadie va al Padre sino por mí”. Si queremos conocer al Padre que resucita a Jesús de entre los muertos y que nos resucitará también a nosotros, debemos escuchar a su Hijo. Es quien nos lo revela. Es el camino que nos conduce al Dios verdadero y dador de vida para toda la humanidad. El Padre de todos, sin distinciones de razas, condición social o género.

De la resurrección de Jesús nace el nuevo pueblo de Dios, en el que Cristo es “la piedra viva desechada por los hombres, pero escogida y preciosa ante Dios”. Un pueblo nuevo que nace del bautismo, no de linaje humano como el pueblo de la antigua alianza, en el que todos podemos relacionarnos directamente con Dios como hijos amados y elegidos para llevar adelante la misión del resucitado. Un pueblo llamado a ser “sacramento universal de fraternidad” en un mundo dividido por las guerras y discriminaciones.
